**“RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MUNICIPAL NUTRITION ACTION PLAN OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BUSTOS, BULACAN FOR 2023-2025.”**

**WHEREAS**, malnutrition is a condition in the body due to lack, or excess, or imbalance on one or more of the nutrients;

**WHEREAS**, based on national nutrition surveys, the nutrition situation of the Philippines can be described to be experiencing the double burden of malnutrition;

**WHEREAS**, while undernutrition is largely prevalent among young children and women, overnutrition is prevalent especially among adults;

**WHEREAS**, undernutrition has far-reaching consequences on child growth and development and the capacity to learn and maximize investments in education as well as the capacity to become economically productive and socially active adults;

**WHEREAS**, overnutrition has been established as one of the risk factors for developing non-communicable disease;

**WHEREAS**, both undernutrition and overnutrition can result to preventable mortality and both can hold back development;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for strategic purposive action address this twin nutritional problem; and the devolution, local government units play a pivotal role in the reversing the trend in both under and overnutrition and in ensuring good nutrition among the population;

**WHEREAS**, the formulation of local nutrition action plans and their integration into the local development plan and annual investment plan will ensure that nutrition action at the local level is strategic and purposive;

**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the Municipal Nutrition Action Plan of the Municipality of Bustos, Bulacan for 2023-2025, which contains the following:

**“EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 19  
S. 2022**

**AN ORDER APPROVING THE MUNICIPAL NUTRITION ACTION  
PLAN OF 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the 1987 Constitution and Republic Act Number 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the Philippines mandates the promotion of the general welfare of the people as essential requisite for the enjoyment by all the people in the blessings of democracy;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Nutrition Action Plan (MNAP) is aligned with the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition (PPAN) 2022-2025, wherein the goal is to contribute to the improvement of the quality of human resource in the country and reduce child and maternal mortality;

**WHEREAS**, in full recognition of the nutritional problems and their dimensions during the planning process, the Municipal Nutrition Action Plan (MNAP) identified a mix of interventions appropriate for the Municipality as defined in PPAN program framework;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Nutrition Action Plan (MNAP) include programs, projects and activities that converge in families of nutritionally vulnerable individuals (with pregnant women, lactating women, children 0-23 months old, or malnourished children under 5 years of age) as well as communities/barangays with high levels of under malnutrition or over nutrition;

**WHEREAS**, the municipality should implement, monitor and evaluate the action plans which include, but not limited to the following PPAN programs and packages:

- a) Pregnant and Lactating Women;
- b) Infant and Young Children (0-23 Months Old);
- c) National Nutrition Promotion for Behavior Change;
- d) Micronutrient Supplementation;
- e) Mandatory Food Fortification;
- f) Philippine Integrated Management of Acute Malnutrition;
- g) National Dietary Supplementation Program;

- h) Nutrition in Emergencies Program;
- i) Overweight and Obesity Management and Prevention Program;
- j) Nutrition sensitive programs that will improve physical and economic access to food, access to sanitary toilets, safe drinking water and responsible parenthood, among others;
- k) Annual conduct of Operation Timbang Plus;
- l) Monitoring of child growth and development especially during the 1<sup>st</sup> 1000 days of life;
- m) Preschool Children (5 years old);
- n) School age children (5-10 years old);
- o) Adolescents (10-19 years old);
- p) Adults (20-59 years old);
- q) Older Adults (60 years old and above);
- r) All Population Groups (Families, Individuals); and
- s) Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH).

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 444(b)(2)(iii) of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, the municipal mayor may issue executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FRANCIS ALBERT G. JUAN**, Mayor of the Municipality of Bustos, by virtue of the powers vested in me, do hereby adopt the Municipal Nutrition Action Plan 2019 with the following provisions:

**SECTION 1. IMPLEMENTATION ---**

1. Direct all department of MGB to translate our commitments into concrete programs/ projects/ activities and initiate all efforts to implement the same; and
2. Include in our Annual Investment Plan and Annual Budget to effectively supplement such programs/projects and activities.

**SECTION 2. COORDINATION/MONITORING OF MNC SECRETARIAT.** --- The Municipal Nutrition Office as the MNC secretariat shall coordinate and monitor the actions leading to the implementation of this order to provide the status report to the MNC Members during its quarterly meeting.


**SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE** --- All issuances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.




**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY** --- This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing.”


